Mel English – Battle Born K9

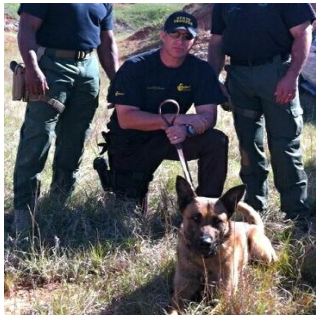
